Granted Royal Charter 1926

Changed its name to The Chartered Institute of
Logistics and Transport in 2001

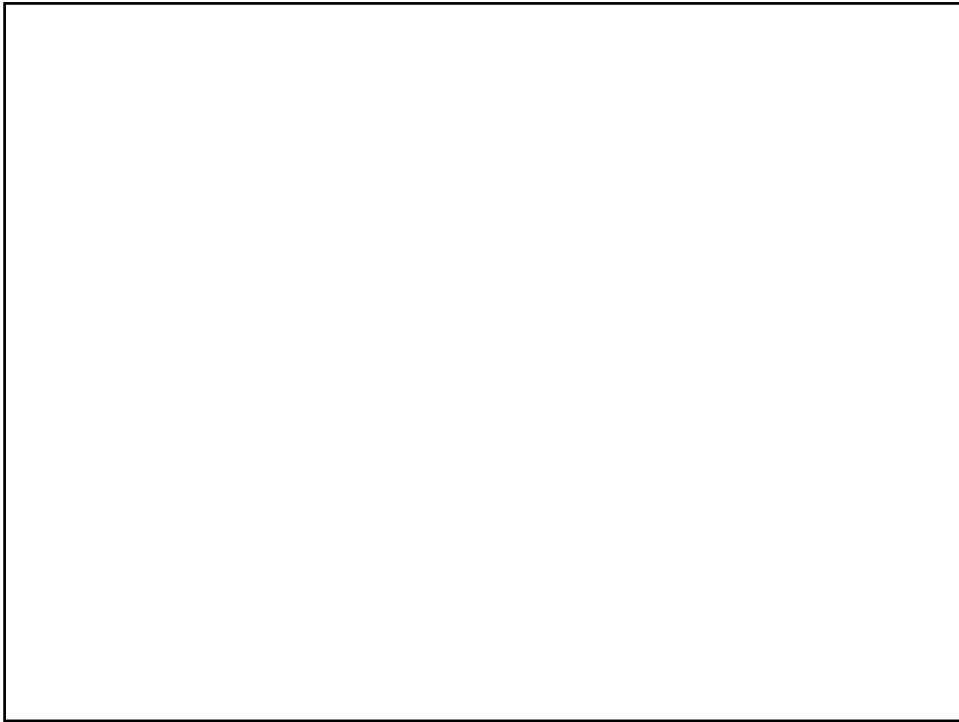
