



Work with sector to:

- Design and roll out plan to embed the data standard and support the sector in this
- Open market for developing/co-creating analytics for national use and sharing
- Move to better balanced model where data valued as an asset



Planning the route ahead

NIP 2015 leads to pilot standards via LINZ framework. 2017 first Standards go live with next stop NZ implementation plan on road to rolling out AMDS for Land Transport. 2019 Plan & on to roll outs NLTP 2021 and 2024, key stops at new approaches, benchmarking, collaboration evidence-based decisions. ETA BAU from 2027
