

# An accessible journeys strategy for Aotearoa

**Disabled peoples' journeys are frequently impossible, often difficult, expensive, and unsafe.**

The transport sector has no systematic way to know whose journeys are difficult, in what ways. So we have an ad-hoc approach to accessibility improvements.

**Accessible transport is about more than infrastructure.**

We need *accessible information, advocacy and attitudes*. We need to work across different sectors as much as possible: just like we do in road safety.
