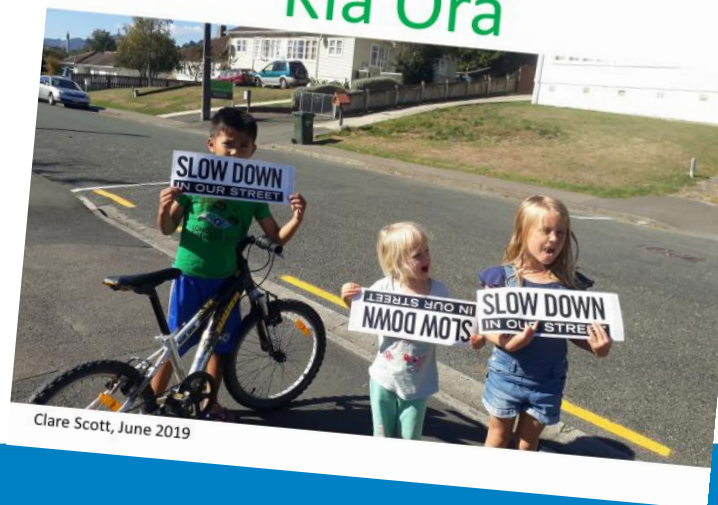


We are asking for our families and the kindergarten to be protected from speeding cars and rat runners from Waimea Rd

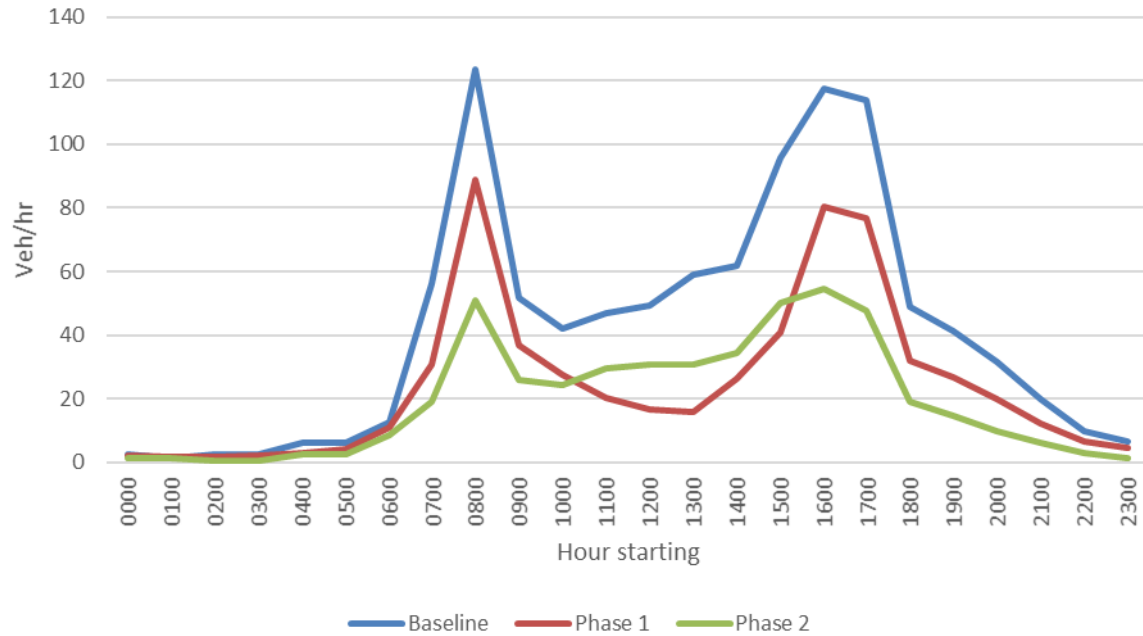

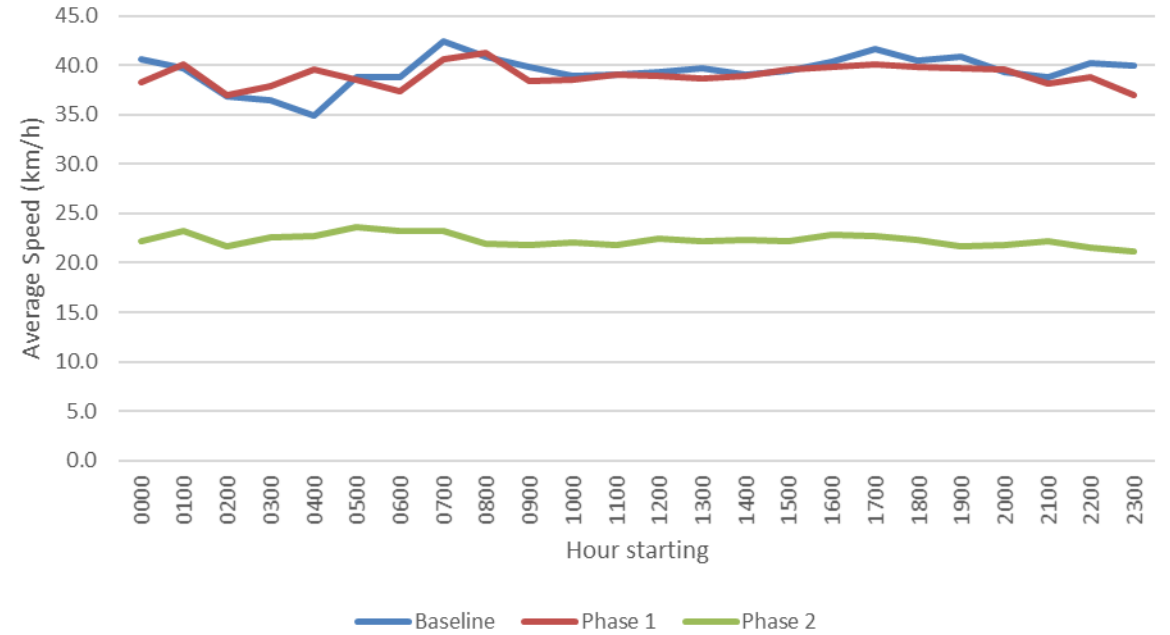
